

Resolution

The Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly records its disapproval of the process adopted for bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh State without adequate consultation with and concurrence of the major stakeholders; and without proper consideration for several adverse consequences.

The Assembly affirms its abiding commitment to the wellbeing of the people of Andhra Pradesh through accelerated and balanced development of the State.

As the Council of Ministers decided that the integrated and equitable development of the State can be best served by locating the capital city at a central place around Vijayawada, the Assembly requests the Government of India to provide the resources required for the establishment of world-class capital city for the State of Andhra Pradesh.

The Assembly resolves to request Government of India that all provisions of Andhra Pradesh Reorganisation Act 2014 relating to the progress and economic development of the State and the Assurances made in the Parliament by the then Prime Minister shall be implemented in letter and spirit at the earliest to enable us to build the new Andhra Pradesh.

The Assembly resolves to request Government of India to take all measures required to create a level playing field for the State of Andhra Pradesh by compensating for the disequilibrium created by bifurcation.

The Assembly resolves to request Government of India to provide necessary financial and policy support for faster and equitable development of the State.

The Assembly further resolves to request the Government of India to take all necessary steps for completion of Polavaram Project within a period of Four years.

The Assembly resolves to request the Government of India to rectify the anomaly in allocating the number of seats in the Andhra Pradesh State Legislative Council and enhance the number of seats to 58 (Fifty Eight) in accordance with the Constitutional provisions.
