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**ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND  
REGULATIONS Etc.,**

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 25<sup>th</sup> October, 2018 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information :-

**ACT No. 32 of 2018**

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL, 2018.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Sixty-ninth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- Short title.* 1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (No.3) Act, 2018.
- Appropriation of Rupees 11212,11,21,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018.*
- Act No.14 of 2018.*
2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2018, a sum not exceeding Eleven thousand two hundred and twelve crores, eleven lakhs and twenty one thousand rupees, in addition to sum of one lakh ninety three thousand nine hundred and twenty three crores, ninety nine lakhs and seventy three thousand rupees, specified in section 2 of the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation Act, 2018, being moneys required to meet,-
- (a) the grants made by the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly for ~~the~~ year, as set-forth in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for ~~the~~ year, as set forth in column (4) of the Schedule.
- Appropriation.* 3. The sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
