## ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.,

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 2<sup>nd</sup> January, 2020 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 3<sup>nd</sup> January, 2020 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

#### ACT No. 10 of 2020.

### AN ACT TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH TOURISM, CULTURE AND HERITAGE BOARD ACT, 2017.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventieth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called The Andhra Pradesh Tourism, Culture and Heritage Board (Amendment) Act, 2019.

Short title and commencement.

- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, appoint.
- 2. In the Andhra Pradesh Tourism, Culture and Heritage Board Act, 2017, in section 6, for sub-section (3), the following sub-section shall be substituted, namely,

Amendment of section 6.
Act No. 4 of 2017.

"(3) An Authority or Commission shall have a maximum of six members, including a chairperson, two official members, not more than two experts in the related field, and a Chief Executive Officer who shall act as the Member-Secretary. The Chairperson maybe nominated by the Government or Board. Whenever a chairperson is not nominated by Government or Board, the Director-General shall act as the Chairperson of the Authority or Commission, constituted for dealing with matters at (a), (b) and (c) in sub section (2) under this section."
