**ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information :

**ACT No. 8 of 2022.**

**AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH OFFICIAL  
LANGUAGES ACT, 1966.**

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Official Languages (Amendment) Act, 2022. Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government may, by notification, in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette, appoint.

2. In the Andhra Pradesh Official Languages Act, 1966, in section 2, Amendment of section 2.  
for the proviso, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely: -

Act No.9 of 1966.

“Provided that the Urdu Language shall be the Second Official Language in all Districts of Andhra Pradesh.”
