**ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND  
REGULATIONS Etc.,**

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 29<sup>th</sup> March, 2022 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information :

ACT No. 1 of 2022.

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL, 2022.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy-third year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation Act, 2022. Short Title.
2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2022, a sum not exceeding Two lakhs sixty seven thousand one hundred and eighty nine crores, ninety eight lakhs and fifty six thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet:- Appropriation of Rupees 267189,98,56,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2022.

(a) the grants made by the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly for the year, as set- forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and

(b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year, as set- forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
