ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 24<sup>th</sup> April, 2023 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information :

ACT No. 8 of 2023

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH DOTTED  
LANDS (UPDATION IN RE-SETTLEMENT REGISTER) ACT, 2017.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows: -

- (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Dotted lands (Updation in Re-settlement Register) (Amendment) Act, 2023. Short Title and Commencement.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from the 29<sup>th</sup> December, 2022.
- In the Andhra Pradesh Dotted lands (Updation in Re-settlement Register) Act, 2017, in section 2, for clause (b), the following shall be substituted, namely,- Amendment of Section 2.  
Act No. 10 of 2017.

“(b) “Dotted Lands” means the lands against which dots were marked in the pattadar column and/or remarks column of the Re Settlement Register or lands where the pattadar column and/or remarks column of the Re-settlement Register was left blank or lands where the expression “Anadheenam” is mentioned in the



pattadar column and/or remarks column of the Re-settlement Register, during the Resurvey and Settlement operations.”

3. (1) The Andhra Pradesh Dotted lands (Updation in Re-settlement Register) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022, is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.
