ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.,

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 20th April, 2023 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 4th May, 2023 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

ACT No. 22 of 2023

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH PUBLIC LIBRARIES ACT, 1960.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows, -

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Public Libraries Short title and commencement. (Amendment) Act, 2023.
 - (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from the 1st January, 2022.
- 2. In the Andhra Pradesh Public Libraries Act, 1960, in Section 19-B,-

Amendment of Section 19-B.

- (i) In the opening paragraph, for the words "sixty years", the words Act 8 of 1960. "sixty two years" shall be substituted.
- (ii) For the first proviso and second proviso thereunder, the following shall be substituted, namely-

"Provided that every employee of Zilla Grandhalaya Samsthas, who retired from service on attaining the age of sixty years during the interregnum period between 1st January, 2022 to

29th November, 2022, shall be re-inducted into the service/post as such with effect from the 29th November, 2022:

Provided further that the said interregnum period from the 1st January, 2022 to 29th November, 2022 shall be treated in such manner as may be prescribed."

Repeal and 3. savings of Ordinance No.14 of 2022.

- (1) The Andhra Pradesh Public Libraries (Amendment) Ordinance, 2022 is hereby repealed.
- (2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.
