The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 31st May, 2021 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 31st May, 2021 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

ACT No. 4 of 2021.

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND AJPPROPRIATION OF MONEY FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1st APRIL, 2021.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy-second year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short Title

Appropriation of Rupees 2. 234657,39,89,000/- from and out of the Consolidated Fund of 1st April, 2021.

Act No. 2 of 2021.

This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (No. 3) Act, 2021. 1.

The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2021, a sum not exceeding two lakhs thirty four thousand six hundred the State of Andhra
Pradesh for the Financial

And fifty seven crores, thirty nine lakhs and eighty nine thousand rupees, which Year commencing on the shall be inclusive of the sum of Rupees seventy thousand nine hundred and eighty three crores, eleven lakhs and seventy nine thousand specified in section 2 of the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act 2021, being moneys required to meet :-

- (a) the grants made by the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly for the year, as set-forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year, as set-forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation

3. The Sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
