## ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.,

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 30<sup>th</sup> March, 2023 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2023 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

## ACT No. 02 of 2023.

AN ACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1<sup>ST</sup> APRIL, 2023.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy-fourth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short Title

1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation Act. 2023.

- 2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the financial year commencing on the 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2023, a sum not exceeding Two lakhs ninety three thousand four hundred forty nine crores, fifty one lakhs and fifty four thousand rupees, being moneys required to meet:-
- (a) the grants made by the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly for the year, as set-forth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year, as set-forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
