The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 20th December, 2022 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 22nd December, 2022 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information :

ACT No. 29 of 2022.

**AN ACT TO REPEAL THE ANDHRA PRADESH CIVIL SERVICES
(DISCIPLINARY PROCEEDINGS TRIBUNAL) ACT, 1960 AND TO
PROVIDE FOR MATTERS CONNECTED THEREWITH OR INCIDENTAL
THERE TO.**

Be it enacted by the legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy Third Year of the Republic of India as follows, -

Short title and
commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Disciplinary Proceedings Tribunal) (Repeal) Act, 2022.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 16th day of August, 2022.

2. (1) The Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Disciplinary Proceedings Tribunal) Act, 1960 is hereby repealed.

Provided that such repeal shall not effect the previous operation of the repealed Act.

(2) From the date on which this Act comes into force, the Tribunal constituted under the repealed Act shall stand abolished and all cases pending before the said Tribunal on the said date shall stand transferred to the Commissionerate of Inquiries (COI) to continue the pending proceedings and shall be disposed of by it in accordance with the statutory rules governing conduct of the disciplinary proceedings in due compliance with principles of natural justice.

Provided that the disciplinary proceedings remaining inconclusive before the Tribunal and challenged before the Honorable courts for remaining inconclusive shall abide by the directions of the courts.

Power to
remove
difficulties.

3. (1) If any difficulty arises in giving effect to the provisions of this Act, the State Government may, by order, do anything not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act as may appear to it to be necessary or expedient for removing the difficulty:

Provided that no such order shall be made after the expiry of two years from the date of commencement of this Act.

(2) Every order made under this Section shall be laid, as soon as may be after it is made, before each House of Legislature.

Repeal and
savings of
Ordinance No. 6

4. (1) The Andhra Pradesh Civil Services (Disciplinary Proceedings Tribunal) (Repeal) Ordinance, 2022 is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under this Act.
