ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.,

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 20th December, 2020 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 24th December, 2020 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

ACT No. 31 of 2020.

AN ACT FURTHER TO AMEND THE ANDHRA PRADESH ASSIGNED LANDS (PROHIBITION OF TRANSFERS) ACT, 1977.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventy First Year of the Republic of India as follows,-

 (1) This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Assigned Lands(Prohibition of Transfers) (Amendment) Act, 2020.

Short Title and commencement.

- (2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 15th September, 2020.
- In the Andhra Pradesh Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) Act, 1977(herein after referred to as the principal Act), in Section 2, in clause(6), for the word, "Lease" wherever it occurs, the words "Lease (except in the case of Lease to the Andhra Pradesh Green Energy Corporation Ltd., for use as deemed fit and including for usage of non-agriculture purpose)" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 2.

3. In the Principal Act, in Section 3,-

(i) in sub-section (2), for the word, "Lease", the words "Lease (except in the case of Lease to the Andhra Pradesh Green Energy Corporation Ltd., for

use as deemed fit and including for usage of non-agriculture purpose)" shall be substituted.

(ii) in sub-section (2A), for the word, "Lease", the words "Lease (except in the case of Lease to the Andhra Pradesh Green Energy Corporation Ltd., for use as deemed fit and including for usage of non-agriculture purpose)" shall be substituted.

Repeal of Ordinance No. 11 of 2020. The Andhra Pradesh Assigned Lands (Prohibition of Transfers) (Amendment) Ordinance,2020 is hereby repealed.
