## ANDHRA PRADESH ACTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATIONS Etc.,

The following Act of the Andhra Pradesh Legislature received the assent of the Governor on the 31th July, 2019 and the said assent is hereby first published on the 31th July, 2019 in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette for general information:

## ACT No. 18 OF 2019

ANACT TO AUTHORISE PAYMENTS AND APPROPRIATION OF MONEYS FROM AND OUT OF THE CONSOLIDATED FUND OF THE STATE OF ANDHRA PRADESH FOR THE SERVICES OF THE FINANCIAL YEAR COMMENCING ON THE 1<sup>5T</sup> APRIL, 2019.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Andhra Pradesh in the Seventieth year of the Republic of India as follows:-

Short Title.

1. This Act may be called the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (No.3) Act, 2019.

Appropriation of Rupees 2.
232287,00,11,000 from St.
and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2019.

2. The State Government may appropriate from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh, for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 2019, a sum not exceeding two lakhs thirty two thousand two hundred and eighty seven crores and eleven thousand rupees, which shall be inclusive of the sum of seventy six thousand eight hundred and sixteen crores, eighty five lakh and ninety eight thousand rupees, specified in section 2 of the Andhra Pradesh Appropriation (Vote-on-Account) Act, 2019, being moneys required to meet:-

Act No.4 of 2019.

- (a) the grants made by the Andhra Pradesh Legislative Assembly for the year, as setforth, in column (3) of the Schedule; and
- (b) the expenditure charged on the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh for the year, as set-forth in column (4) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorized to be appropriated from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Andhra Pradesh by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
